The Pillager Clay Target Team is gearing up for the 2022 Spring Season and we are glad you're here!

TO REGISTER – Student athlete registration begins February 1st and ends on February 17th. All participants (new and returning) must complete the on-line registration.

Once you have completed the registration form, signed and returned ALL paperwork, and paid:

RETURNING ATHLETES – you will be sent an email inviting you to update your profile/register. Once completed, coaches are notified. *(Be sure to update ALL OF THE INFO in your profile, including shirt size and grade you are currently in)*

NEW ATHELETES – You will be asked to create a new profile. Once that is completed, coaches are notified

COSTS:

Team Membership is dependent on the Athletes/Parents commitment to our practice/competition schedule, rules and purpose.

The first 40 trap, 10 skeet and 20 sporting clays fully completed team registration forms/fees received before February 17th deadline will be considered for a place on the 2022 Trap and Skeet Team. Return completed form and check to Coach David or Heather.

- **COSTS:** TRAP - \$300 for all athletes. OR \$350 for athletes who wish to have a business/individual sponsor-see sponsor sheet for more details. (This **DOES NOT INCLUDE** the \$35 registration fee with the Minnesota State High School Clay Target League.) This includes all ammunition, clay targets, rounds, t-shirt, sweatshirt, and ball cap.
- SPORTING - \$400 for all athletes – OR \$450 for athletes who wish to have a business/individual sponsor – see sponsor sheet for more details. (This **DOES NOT INCLUDE** the \$35 registration fee with the Minnesota State High School Clay Target League.) This includes all ammunition, clay targets, rounds, t-shirt, sweatshirt, and ball cap.
- COMBINED SPORTS - \$700 for all athletes – OR \$750 for athletes who wish to have a business/individual sponsor – see sponsor sheet for more details. (This **DOES NOT INCLUDE** the \$70 registration fee with the Minnesota State High School Clay Target League.) This includes all ammunition, clay targets, rounds, t-shirt, sweatshirt, and ball cap.
- **Make Check Payable to Pillager School** – All registration checks will be cashed after February 28th.
- **Team Size is limited to 40 Trap, 10 skeet and 20 Sporting Clays.**
- Members **must** be 12 years of age and have a MN DNR Firearms Safety Hunter Education Certificate or SAFE Certificate.
- All Practice and Competitions will be held (snow, rain, or shine) at Lakeshore Gun Club on **Sundays from 2:00-5:00. Sporting Clays will be held at Hunts Point on Saturday from 2:00 - 5:00. These can change. Please watch your emails for changes.**
- **Must** have transportation to and from Lakeshore Gun Club and Hunts Point each week.
- Competition scores are posted weekly on the league website
- **You must notify the head coach if you cannot make a practice or competition day ahead of time.**
- Lakeshore Gun Club hosts 2 High School Teams (Brainerd and Pillager) and Central Lakes College.
- **Team Members/Parents will be required to help raise funds to help offset costs of this sport. We will have at least three mandatory fundraising events this year.**
- Successful Registrants will be notified by e-mail. (Important Information will be provided).

Independent Provider High School Extra Curricular Lettering Program Example

School name, in conjunction with the Minnesota State High School Clay Target League (MSHSCTL), has developed an Independent Provider Extra Curricular Lettering Program for shooting sports. The requirements set forth in this policy are meant to be an equivalent to other varsity lettering requirements for this high school's sports.

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAM

1. To offer high school athletic status to shooting sport student athletes.
2. To recognize the accomplishments and time commitment of shooting sport student athletes with a varsity letter award to those who meet the requirements as defined by the high school. Official high school athletic recognition is important to college applicants.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR LETTERING

To be eligible for the Independent Provider Extra Curricular Lettering Program, the shooting sport student athlete must meet the following criteria:

1. Athlete must be a student of *School name and ISD#* in grades 9-12.
2. Home schooled athletes in this school district are also eligible.
3. Athlete must abide by *School name and ISD#* and Minnesota State High School Clay Target League activity requirements.
4. Athlete must average 20 or more points per round in competition play at the end of the season.
5. Athlete must not miss any competition weeks during the season.
6. Athlete must adhere to all school district rules, policies and requirements concerning student activities including, but not limited to, attendance, conduct, scholastic standing and other eligibility requirements.
7. Athlete may participate in the State Tournament.
8. Athlete must submit all necessary documentation and associated fees to the school's Lettering Coordinator by *date*.

If a student athlete fails to adhere to the Qualification and Requirements for Lettering, the athlete forfeits the right to letter for that season.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS

School name letters, shooting sport patch, bars, and certificate will be awarded to the qualifying recipients at *event name and date*. In addition participating students will be invited to be included in the clay target team photo for the school's yearbook.

MSHSL Eligibility Brochure

Students: Your participation in high school activities is dependent on your eligibility. I understand I must sign the current eligibility statement prior to participation each school year.

I understand that once I sign the eligibility statement all eligibility rules apply:

- 12 months of the year;
- Whether I am currently participating or not;
- Continuously from the first signing of the statement through the completion of my high school eligibility.

Parents/Guardians: REVIEW the following rules with your son or daughter. Your role in stressing the value of following these rules cannot be overstated.

General Student Eligibility Checklist (must be completed by all students) *(If you cannot check all 8 items, see your athletic/activities director or principal)*

- _____ 1. Making academic progress toward graduation.
- _____ 2. Will not have turned 20 before the start of the season in which I participate.
- _____ 3. Have not dropped out of school or repeated a grade beginning with the initial entrance in the 7th grade.
- _____ 4. Have not and will not use or possess tobacco or alcoholic beverages, use, consume, have in possession, buy, sell or give away any other controlled substance, including steroids, drug paraphenalia or products containing or used to deliver nicotine, tobacco products and other chemicals.
- _____ 5. Have not and will not violate the racial/religious/sexual harassment/violence/and hazing bylaws of the MSHSL
- _____ 6. I agree to fully cooperate in any investigation honestly and truthfully.
- _____ 7. Regardless of my age I agree to follow all of the MSHSL Bylaws in order to be eligible to represent my school in League-sponsored activities.
- _____ 8. Both the student and parent have reviewed the concussion management information contained in the Eligibility Brochure and found on the following website: www.cdc.gov/headsup

Athletic Eligibility Checklist (must be completed by all athletes) *(If you cannot check all 5 items, see your athletic/activities director or principal)*

- _____ 1. Physical exam within the last three (3) years on file with the school.
- _____ 2. Have not transferred schools.
- _____ 3. Will not participate in more than six (6) seasons in any sport in grades 7-12.
- _____ 4. Have not accepted cash in any amount or merchandise valued at more than \$100 for participating in a sport.
- _____ 5. Have not and will not compete in non-school events in my sport after reporting for the school team.

INFORMED CONSENT: By its nature, participation in interscholastic athletics includes risk of injury and the transmission of infectious diseases such as HIV, Hepatitis B, herpes and others. Although serious injuries are not common, and the risk of HIV transmission is almost nonexistent in supervised school athletic programs, it is impossible to eliminate all risk. Participants have the responsibility to help reduce that risk. Participants must obey all safety rules, report all physical and hygiene problems to their coaches, follow a proper conditioning program, and inspect their own equipment daily.
